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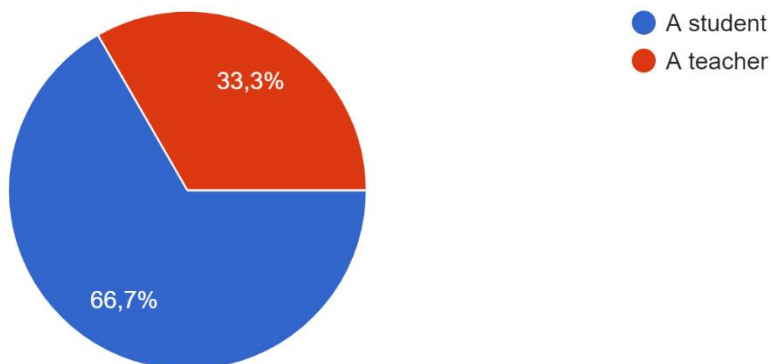
### **UNIFICATION IN DIVERSITY**

This is a questionnaire which was applied to the participants in the 1st Learning, Teaching and Training Activities, on the last day of the activities.

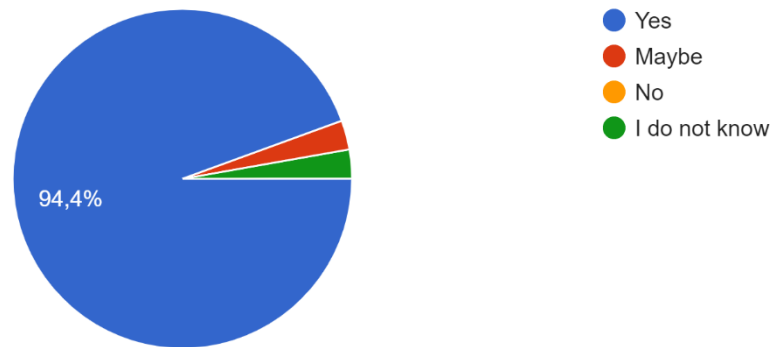
1. Are you a student or a teacher?

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2. Do you think that the 1st meeting achieved the results that the project's objectives had targeted at?

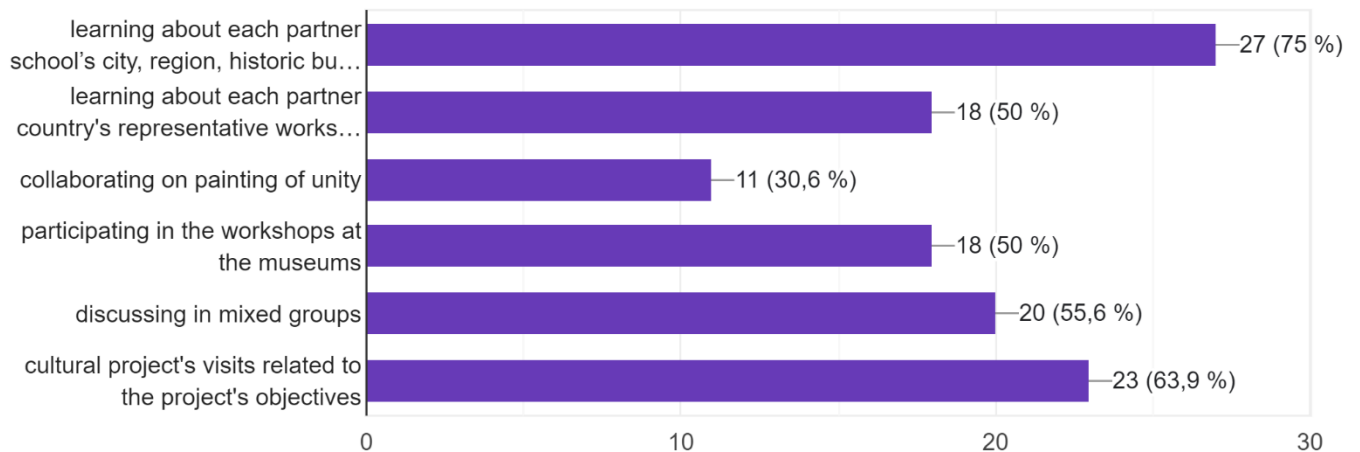
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Most participants, 94,4%, considered that the activities were a success and the way they were organised led to the achievement of the project meeting's targeted objectives.

3. Which activities did you like best? You may choose as many as possible.

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70% of the respondents liked learning about each partner school's city, region, historic buildings, monuments.

50% of the respondents chose as one of their favourite activities, learning about each partner country's representative works of art.

30,6 % of the respondents said that collaborating on painting of unity was one of their favourite activities.

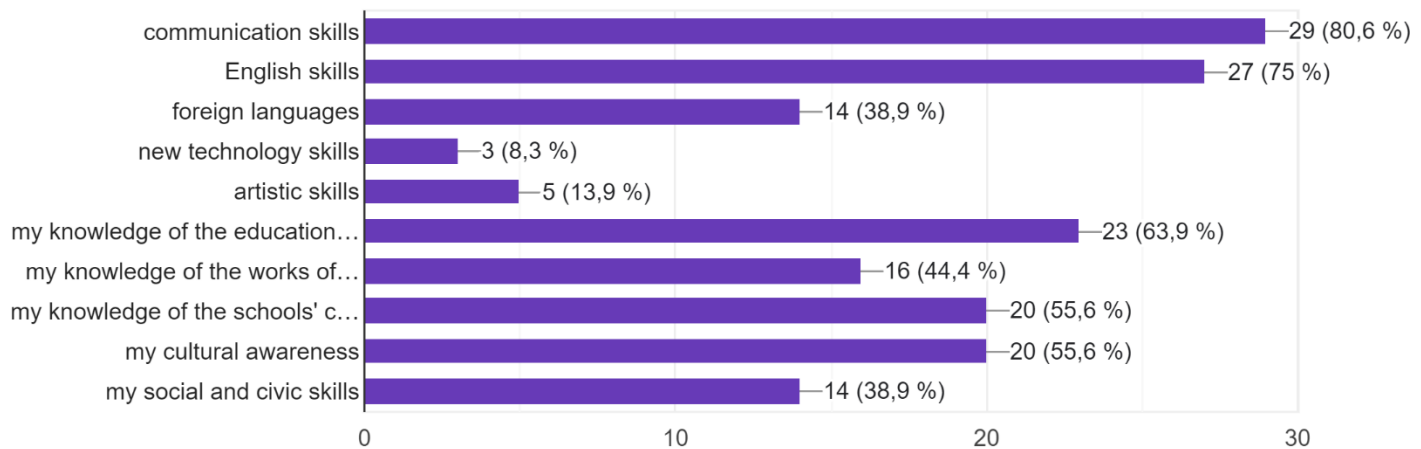
50% of the respondents selected participating in the workshops at the museums as one of the best activities.

For 55,6 % of the respondents, discussing in mixed groups was one of the best activities.

63,9 % of the respondents selected cultural project's visits related to the project's objectives as one of the activities they enjoyed most during the 1<sup>st</sup> LTT activities.

#### 4. What skills/ competences/ knowledge/ attitudes did you acquire or improve during the activities that took place during this meeting? You may choose more than one.

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The respondents' answers regarding the skills, competences, knowledge and attitudes that they acquired or improved during these LTT activities, were as follows:

Communication skills- 80,6%

English skills-75 %

Foreign languages- 38,9 %

New technology skills- 8,3 %

Artistic skills -13,9%

My knowledge of the educational system in Poland and in the other partner schools-63,9%

My knowledge of the works of art in my country and of the partner countries-44,4%

My knowledge of the schools' city, region, historic buildings, monuments-55,6%

My cultural awareness-55,6%

My social and civic skills- 38,9 %

**7. What will you remember most from this project's meeting?**

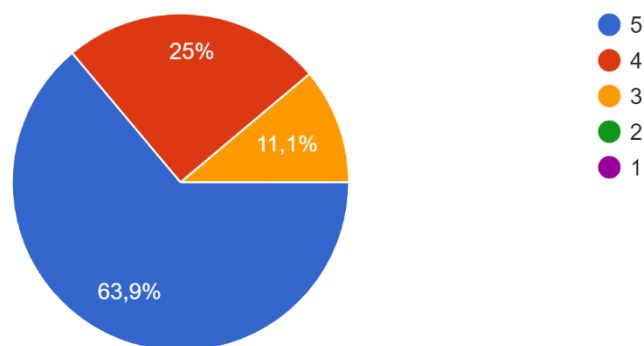
The respondents' answers were:

8. How was the general atmosphere during the mobility from Jelenia Góra? (5- maximum, 1 minimum)

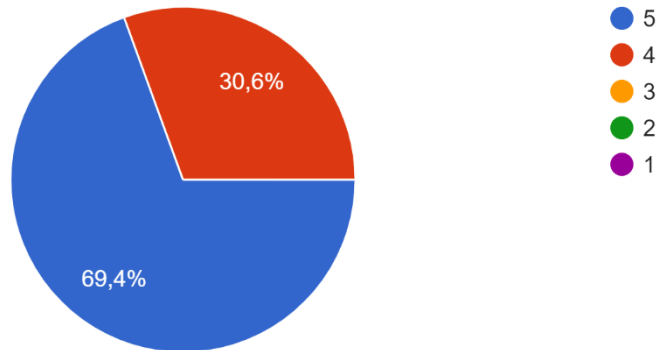
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The vast majority of the respondents considered that during the project mobility the atmosphere was a great one, rating this with 5- 63,9% from the participants and 4- 25% from the participants.

9. Do you think that the project will have a positive impact on the students and teachers from the six schools? ( 5- maximum, 1 minimum)

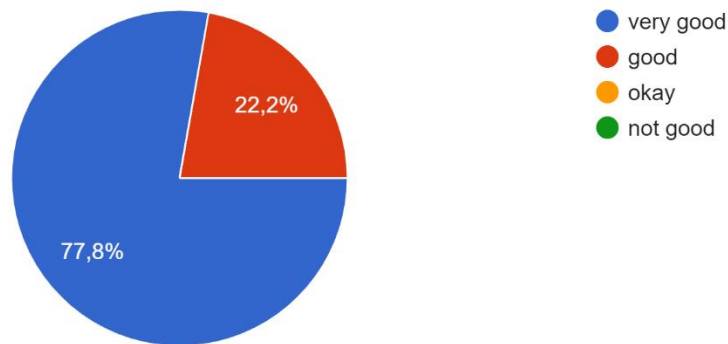
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The respondents considered that the project would have a positive impact on both students and teachers from the partner schools.
