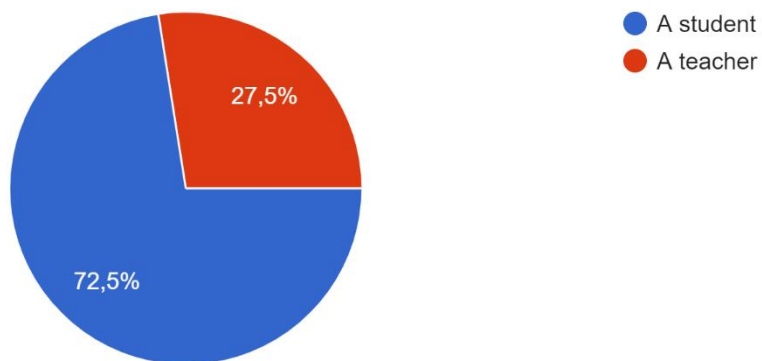
UNIFICATION IN DIVERSITY

This is a questionnaire which was applied to the participants in the 2nd Learning, Teaching and Training Activities, on the last day of the activities.

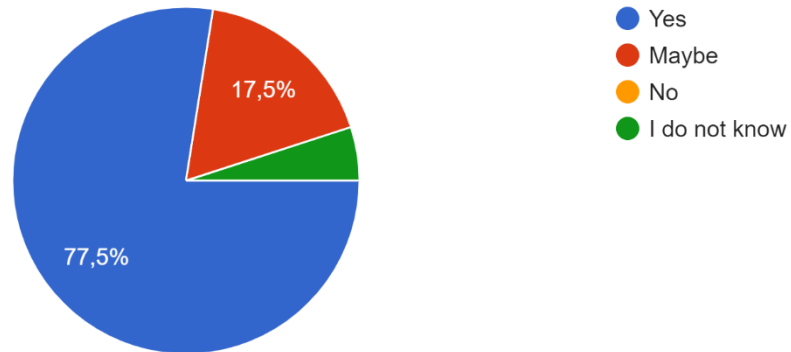
1. Are you a student or a teacher?

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2. Do you think that the 2nd meeting achieved the results that the project's objectives had targeted at?

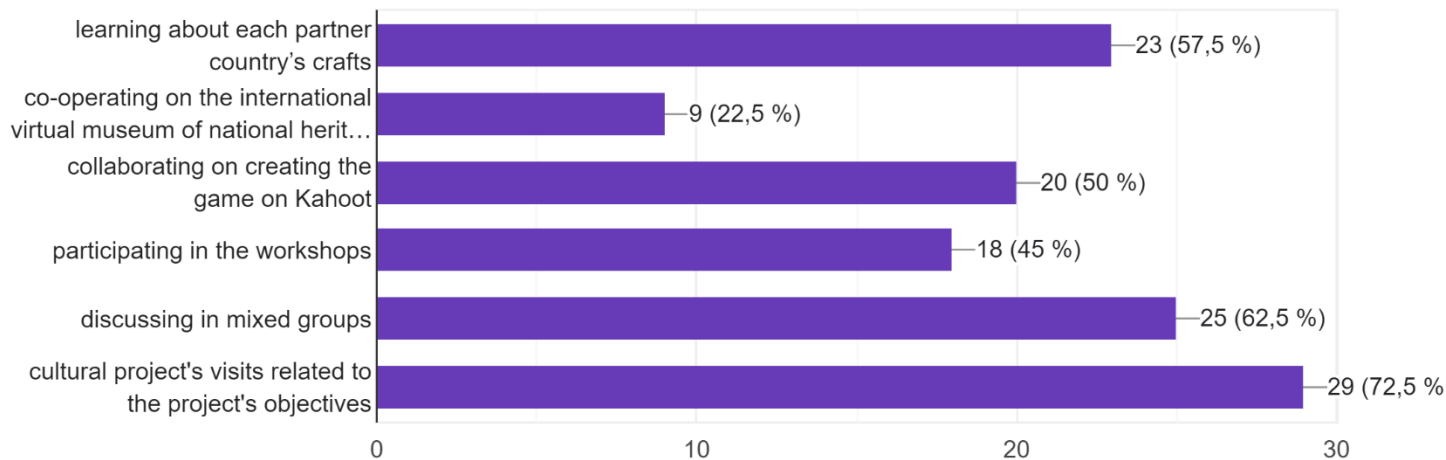
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Most participants considered that the activities were a success and the way they were organised led to the achievement of the project meeting's targeted objectives.

3. Which activities did you like best? You may choose as many as possible.

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57,5% of the respondents liked learning about each partner country's crafts

22,5 % of the respondents chose as one of their favourite activities, co-operating on the international virtual museum of national heritage.

50 % of the respondents said that collaborating on creating the game on Kahoot was one of their favourite activities.

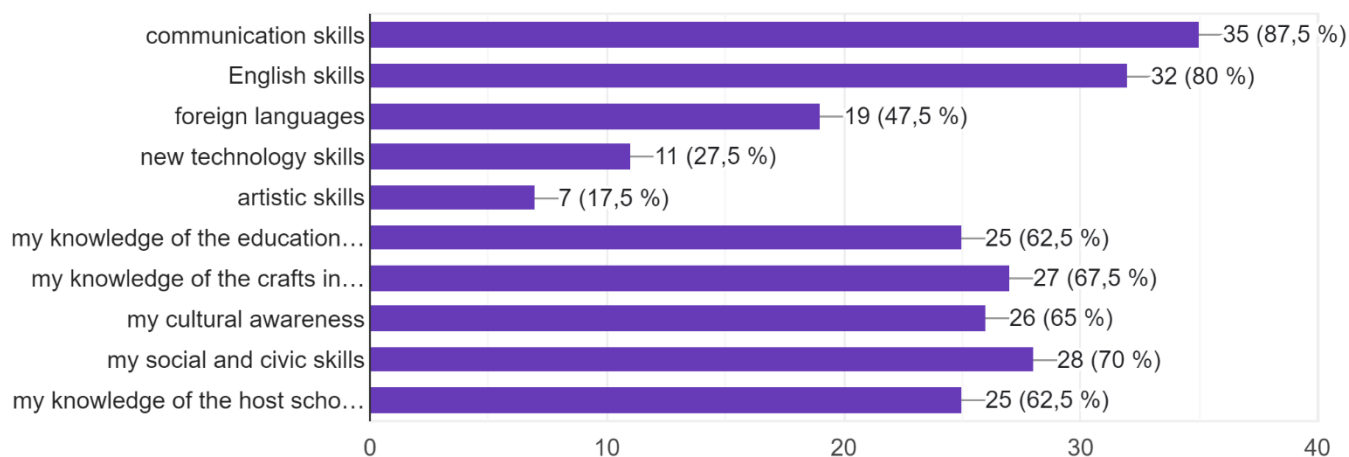
45% of the respondents selected participating in the workshops as one of the best activities.

For 62,5 % of the respondents, discussing in mixed groups was one of the best activities.

72,5 % of the respondents selected cultural project's visits related to the project's objectives as one of the activities they enjoyed most during the 2nd LTT activities.

4. What skills/ competences/ knowledge/ attitudes did you acquire or improve during the activities that took place during this meeting? You may choose more than one.

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The respondents' answers regarding the skills, competences, knowledge and attitudes that they acquired or improved during these LTT activities, were as follows:

Communication skills- 87,5%

English skills-80 %

Foreign languages- 47,5 %

New technology skills- 27,5 %

Artistic skills -17,5 %

My knowledge of the education system in Italy and in the other partner schools-62,5%

My knowledge of the crafts in my country and of the partner countries-67,5%

My knowledge of the host school's city, region, historic buildings-62,5%

My cultural awareness-65%

My social and civic skills- 70 %

5. What similarities between your cultures (your own country's culture and your host country's culture) did you see? If you are a member of the host team, what similarities between your country's culture and the partner countries' cultures did you see? (Please, give the most important ones).

7. What will you remember most from this project's meeting?

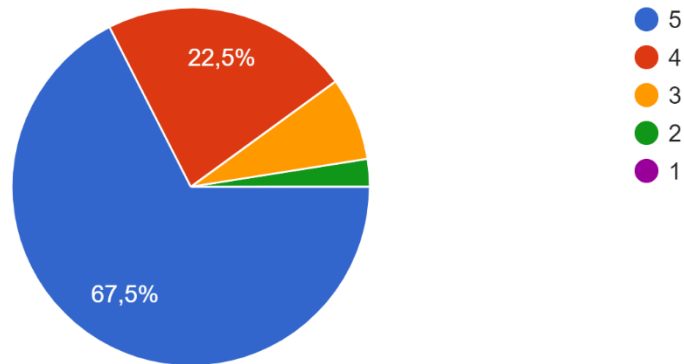
The respondents' answers were:

8. How was the general atmosphere during the mobility from Noto? (5- maximum, 1 minimum)

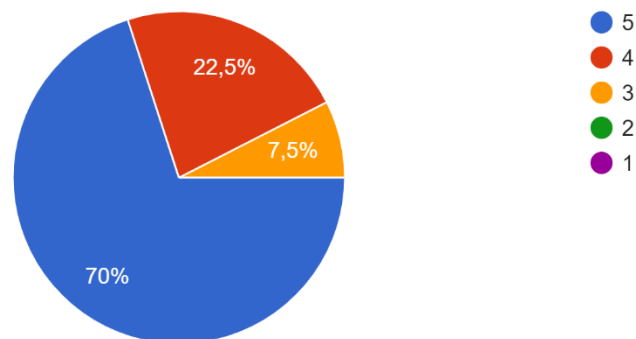

9. Do you think that the project will have a positive impact on the students and teachers from the six schools? (5- maximum, 1 minimum)

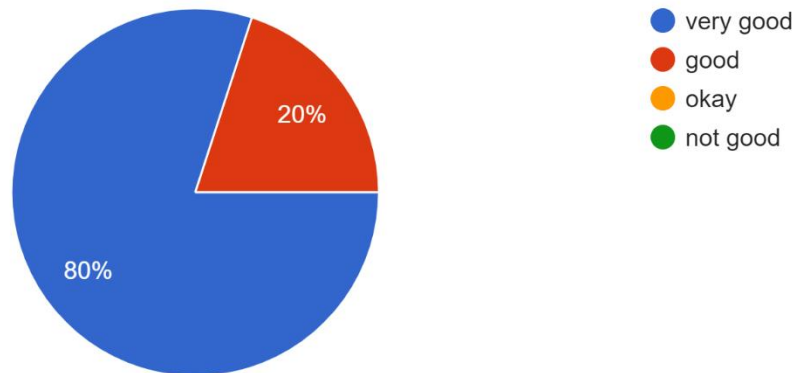
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The respondents considered that the project would have a positive impact on both students and teachers from the partner schools.
