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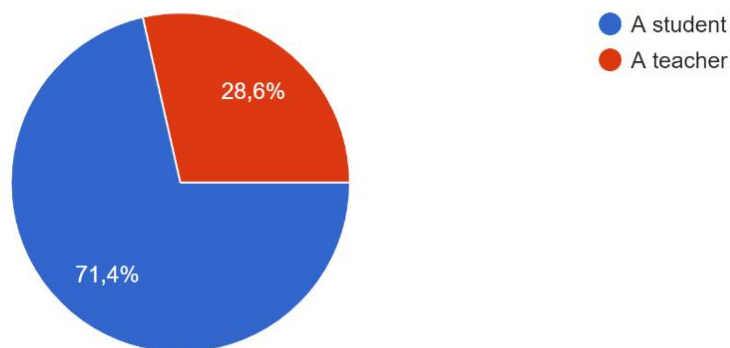
## **UNIFICATION IN DIVERSITY**

1. Are you a student or a teacher?

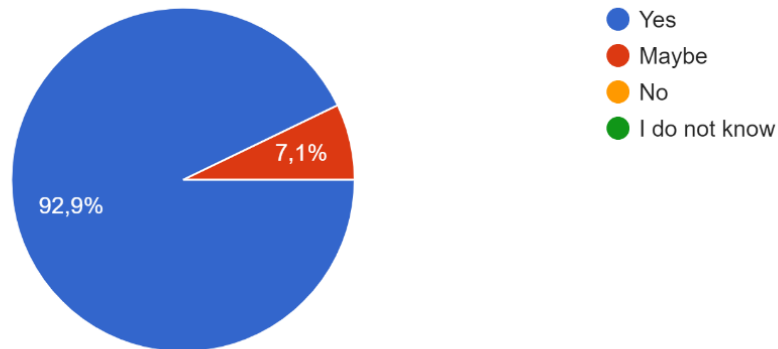

2. Do you think that the 4th meeting achieved the results that the project's objectives had targeted at?

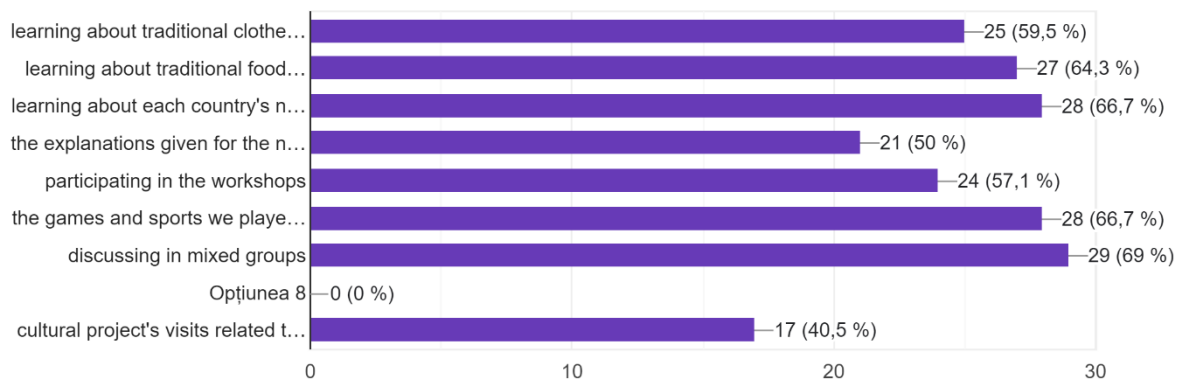

Most participants, 92,9%, considered that the activities were a success and the way they were organised led to the achievement of the project meeting's targeted objectives.

59,5% of the respondents liked learning about traditional clothes that tell a story about national heritage

64,3% of the respondents chose as one of their favourite activities learning about traditional food and making suggestions for healthy eating based on the traditional food

66,7 % of the respondents said that learning about each country's national sports and games was one of their favourite activities.

50% of the respondents selected the explanations given for the national sports and games in terms of cultural heritage as one of the best activities.

57,1% of the respondents said that participating in the workshops was one of their favourite activities.

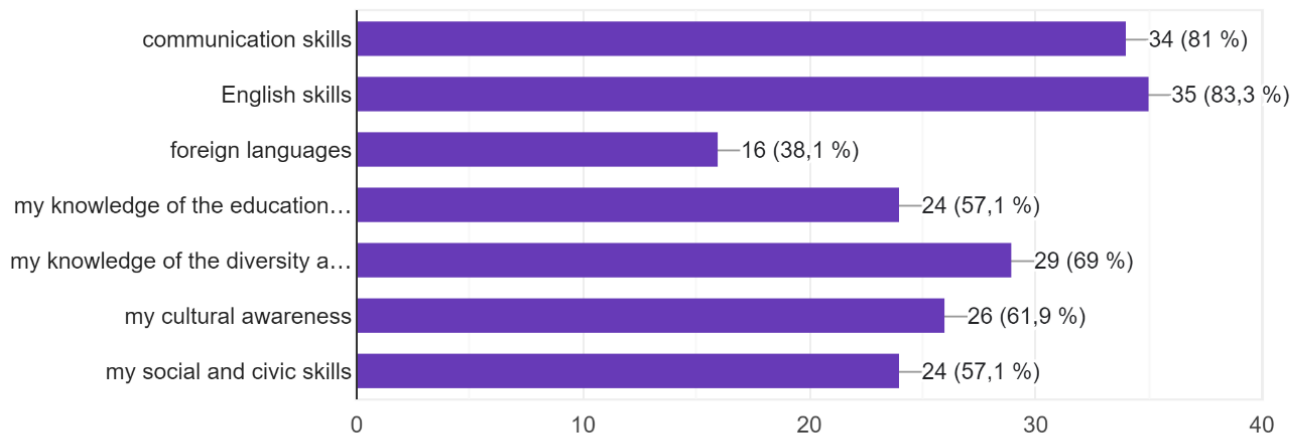
66,7 % of the respondents selected the games and sports we played in mixed teams, as a favourite activity.

For 69 % of the respondents, discussing in mixed groups was one of the best activities.

40,5 % of the respondents selected cultural project's visits related to the project's objectives as one of the activities they enjoyed most during the 4th LTT activities.

The respondents' answers regarding the skills, competences, knowledge and attitudes that they acquired or improved during these LTT activities, were as follows:

Communication skills- 81%

English skills-83,3%

Foreign languages- 38,1%

My knowledge of the educational system in the Republic of North Macedonia and in the other partner schools-57,1%

My knowledge of the diversity and traditions in my country and of the partner countries-69%

My cultural awareness-61,9%

My social and civic skills- 57,1 %

The part that we met each other and had fun with the others.

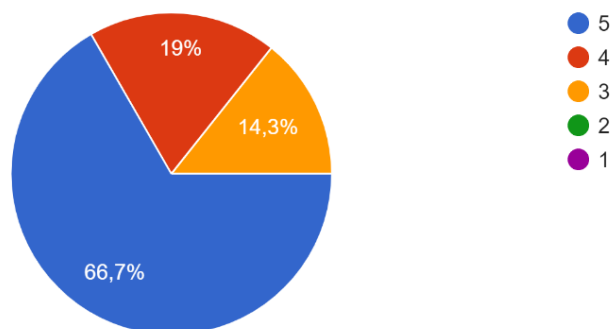
I will remember the people I met the most.

8. How was the general atmosphere during the mobility from Prilep? ( 5- maximum, 1 minimum)

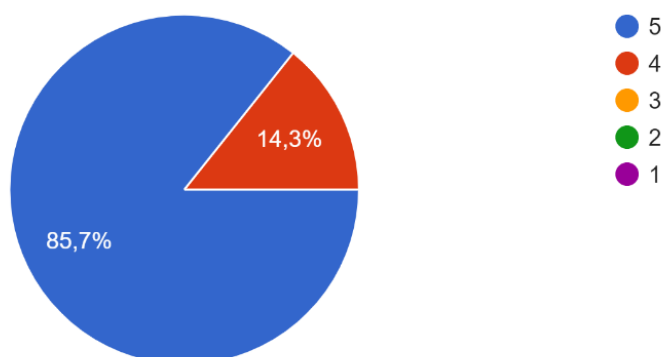

9. Do you think that the project will have a positive impact on the students and teachers from the six schools? ( 5- maximum, 1 minimum)

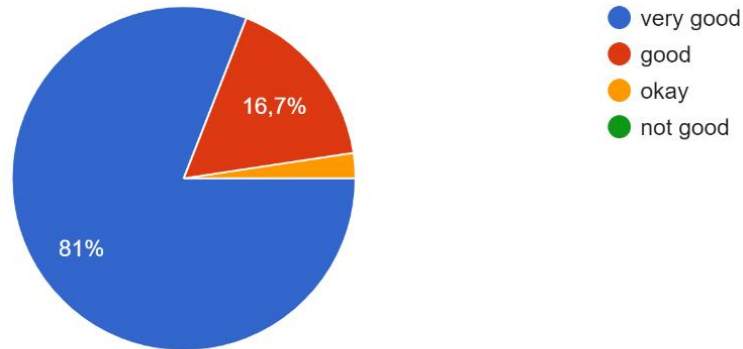
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The respondents considered that the project would have a positive impact on both students and teachers from the partner schools.
