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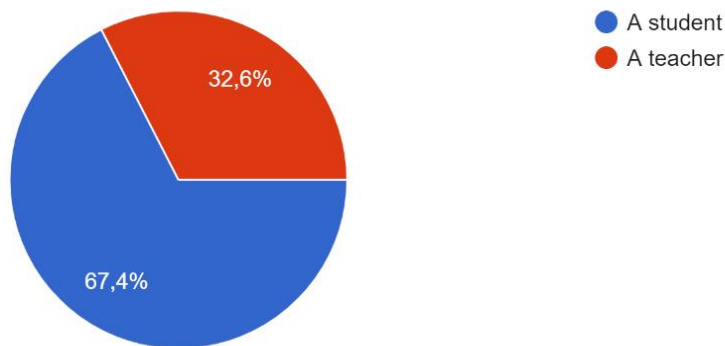
UNIFICATION IN DIVERSITY

The evaluation of the 5th learning, teaching and training activities that took place at T.C. KDZ.EREGLI KAYMAKAMLIGI IBRAHIM-SUHEYLA IZMIRLI FEN LISESI, Eregli, Zonguldak, Turkey, 12.03.2023-18.03.2023

1. Are you a student or a teacher?

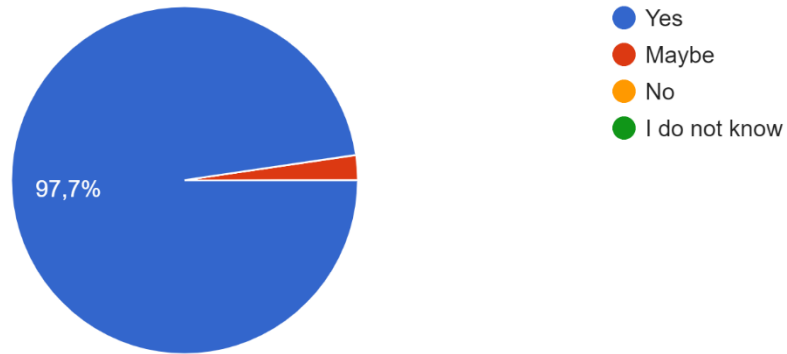
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There were 29 students and 14 teachers who answered the evaluation questionnaire for the 5th learning, teaching and training activities.

2. Do you think that the 5th meeting achieved the results that the project's objectives had targeted at?

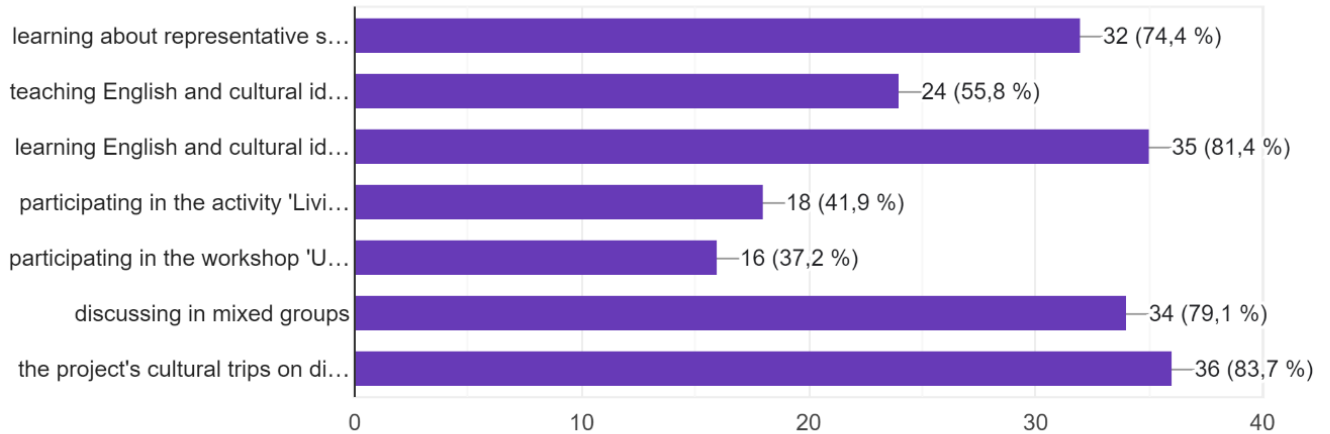
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Most participants, 97,7%, considered that the activities were a success and the way they were organised led to the achievement of the project meeting's targeted objectives.

3. Which activities did you like best? You may choose as many as possible.

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74,4% of the respondents liked learning about representative stories from each partner country

55,8% of the respondents chose as one of their favourite activities teaching English and cultural identity through stories

81,4 % of the respondents said that learning English and cultural identity through stories was one of their favourite activities.

41,9% of the respondents selected participating in the activity 'Living Libraries' as one of the best activities.

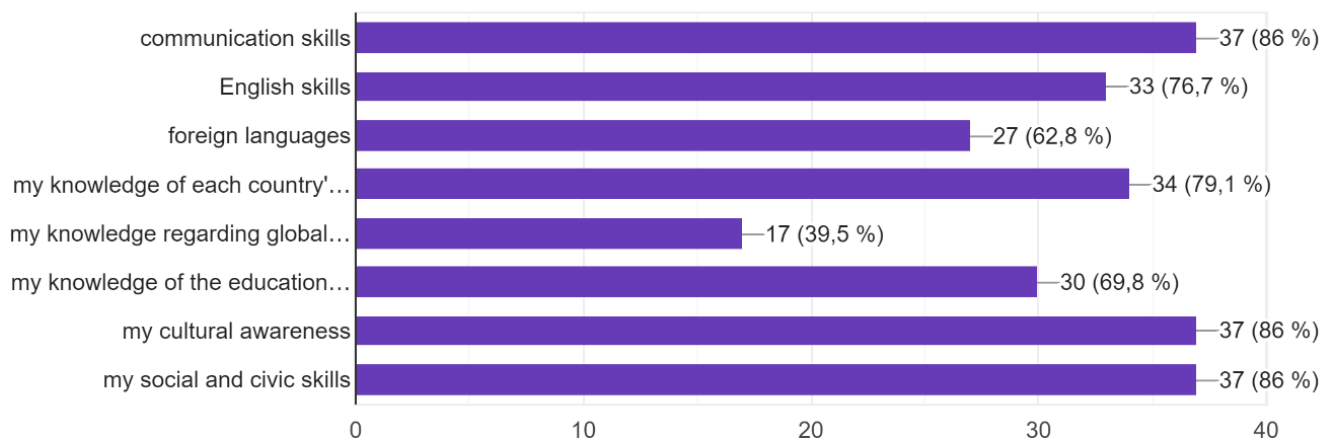
37,2% of the respondents said that participating in the workshop 'Unity and Diversity through Globalization, Glocalization and National Identity'. was one of their favourite activities.

For 79,1 % of the respondents, discussing in mixed groups was one of the best activities.

83,7 % of the respondents selected cultural project's visits related to the project's objectives as one of the activities they enjoyed most during the 5th LTT activities.

4. What skills/ competences/ knowledge/ attitudes did you acquire or improve during the activities that took place during this meeting? You may choose more than one.

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The respondents' answers regarding the skills, competences, knowledge and attitudes that they acquired or improved during these LTT activities, were as follows:

Communication skills- 86%

English skills-76,7%

Foreign languages- 62,8%

My knowledge of each country's stories with references to national identity-79,1%

My knowledge regarding globalization and glocalization-39,5%

My knowledge of the educational system in Turkey and in the other partner schools-69,8%

My cultural awareness-86%

My social and civic skills- 86 %

The interactions that I had with my school partners.

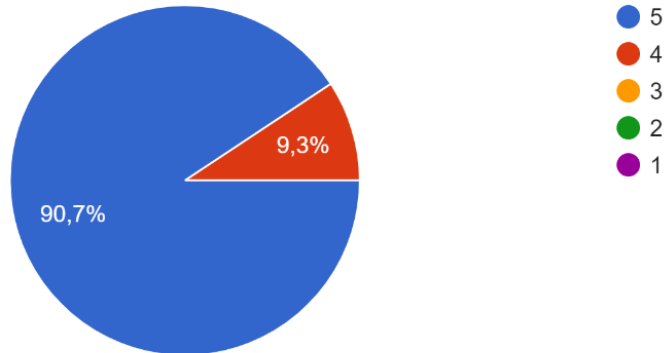
The people I met and the way we communicated.

8. How was the general atmosphere during the mobility from Turkey? (5- maximum, 1 minimum)

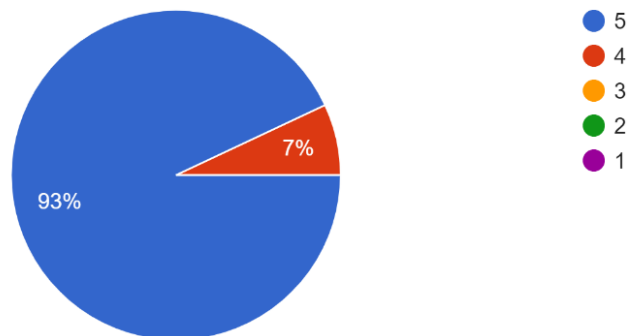

9. Do you think that the project will have a positive impact on the students and teachers from the six schools? (5- maximum, 1 minimum)

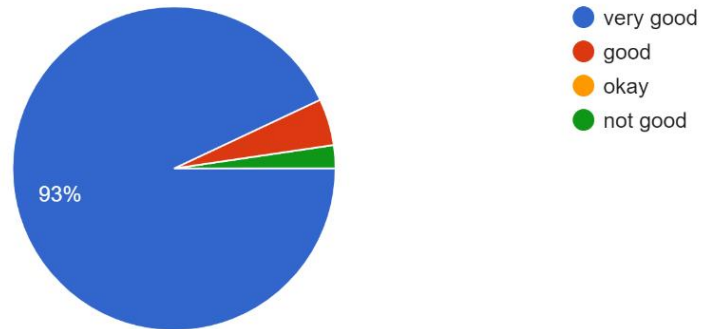
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The respondents considered that the project would have a positive impact on both students and teachers from the partner schools, rating it with 5- 93% of the respondents and with 4-7% of the respondents.
