




This is a questionnaire which was applied to the participants in the 6th Learning, Teaching and Training Activities, on the last day of the activities.






There were 33 students and 15 teachers who answered the evaluation questionnaire for the 6th learning, teaching and training activities.


2.Do you think that the 6th meeting achieved the results that the project's objectives had targeted at?

Most participants, 95,8%, considered that the activities were a success and the way they were organised led to the achievement of the project meeting's targeted objectives.

72,9% of the respondents liked learning about each country's most culturally significant landscapes and their presence in our cultural heritage

50% of the respondents chose as one of their favourite activities learning about the preservation of culture, traditions and customs with a positive impact on the environment and the necessary steps on how we should protect the environment while doing this

66,7 % of the respondents said that learning about "Cultural diversity and unity' through the film episodes that were made for the 6 learning, teaching and training activities was one of their favourite activities.

70,8% of the respondents selected exchanging ideas in mixed teams for shooting the last episode of "Cultural diversity and unity"


45,8% of the respondents said that shooting the last episode of 'Cultural diversity and unity' was one of their favourite activities.

79,2 % of the respondents selected the project's cultural trips on discovering national identity

For 58,3 % of the respondents, participating in the lessons that were taught at Colegiul National "Ion Luca Caragiale" from Moreni, was one of the best activities.

The respondents' answers regarding the skills, competences, knowledge and attitudes that they acquired or improved during these LTT activities, were as follows:

Talking to the other students.


My friends and the landscapes.

Friendliness that was the key word of the meeting.


8. How was the general atmosphere during the mobility from Romania? (5- maximum, 1 minimum)




The vast majority of the respondents considered that during the project meeting the atmosphere was a great one, rating this with 5-81,3% of the participants, with 4-18,8% of the participants.

The respondents considered that the project would have a positive impact on both students and teachers from the partner schools, rating it with 5-89,6% of the respondents, with 4-8,3% of the respondents and with 3-2,1% of the respondents.
